

## DEVIO – Mantis Report an Issue

### 1. Account Registration. Check your e-mail!

DEVIO will send you an e-mail to register in Mantis Bug Tracker, in order to report issues for your websites and web applications.

### 2. Type your password.

Choose and type your password wisely. It is the one you'll use every time you wish to login on <https://www.devio.gr/mantis>.


